About the Workshop: Financial freedom is crucial for empowering people to make independent choices, secure their future, and lead a dignified life. For women, it becomes even more significant, as they make up half of the population; women's active participation in the economy is essential for the country's holistic development. When women are financially independent, they not only contribute to household stability but also drive economic growth and societal development. Empowering women financially is pre-requisite for achieving inclusive growth, social equity, and national advancement as India moves towards becoming a Viksit Bharat@2047. However, this potential remains largely untapped in many rural areas, where women still face significant barriers to financial independence, such as lack of access to resources, limited education, and social constraints.

In the light of this, MANUU College of Teacher Education-Bhopal is going to organize a one-day workshop to engage local community (women) at Gram Panchayat compound of a nearby "Kurana" village as part of Community Engagement to address these challenges and empower them.
