The IQAC has developed the feedbacks and appraisal forms for all the stakeholders. The Centre for Information Technology (CIT) has digitized these feedbacks, and developed a system of automated analysis of these feedbacks. The student feedback has gone online in December 2018 before they took the odd semester examinations. Though this time the feedback was not made compulsory, the response from the students was massive as more than 1200 students responded. The Director CIT has also digitized *Students Satisfaction Survey*.

2) The approval of the 2017-2018 AQAR of IQAC

3) Volunteering for re-assessment for improvement in accredited status-Reg. In the First Meeting of the IQAC held on 28th May 2018, it was decided that the University shall volunteer for re-assessment for improvement in the accredited status. Though the University has been accredited with A Grade with 3.09 score by NAAC, it was decided to volunteer for the sake of protecting ODL programmes. For the continuation of these programmes UGC had stipulated 3.26 score on a 4-point scale.

However, the UGC has notified the UGC (ODL) Third Amendment Regulations, 2018, in the Official Gazette on 6th September 2018, which amends the 2017 Regulations. The point related with ODL regulation reads as:



'Provided that the Higher Educational Institutions shall submit an undertaking to the effect that it will attain a National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) score of 3.26 on a 4 point scale before the end of academic session July 2019-2020, failing which, the Commission shall not accord any approval to the Open and Distance Learning Programmes of the Higher Educational Institutions.'
