**About Project:** United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) has collaborated with Maulana Azad National Urdu University in a project on Adolescence Education Program (AEP) in Madarsas of Bihar. AEP aims at enhancing and strengthening lifelong learning of adolescents. MANUU will seek to strengthen the capacities of teachers in Madarsas through regular trainings of Nodal teachers and developing Resource Centres at a unit of 40 Madarsas. For a cluster of average 40 Madarsas a Resource Centre shall function to provide trainings, refreshers and supportive supervisions. At each RC there shall be three Trainers (previously called Master Trainers) and one Facilitator.

Maulana Azad National Urdu University is an important partner in this endeavor and has been mandated for Training of Nodal Teachers, Supportive Supervision and nurturing Resource Centers.
