About Project: UNICEF India is national communication partner to Government of India in its emergency response to COVID 19. It supports the GOI and other states through its field offices in designing and implementation of Risk Communication and Community Engagement (RCCE) to promote COVID appropriate Behaviours (CAB) and promotion of COVID vaccine uptake. As part of this UNICEF Hyderabad Field Office of UNICEF is working with the state governments of Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, and Karnataka. In addition to this UNICEF has established strategic partnerships with premier research and academic institutions, civil society organisations and network of professional institutes to build community action to mitigate the impact of COVID 19 on the vulnerable population groups.

Though the new infections are on a declining trend in the last two months and an augmented vaccination program has so far vaccinated 100 crore people with at least single dose of vaccine. The epidemiologist strongly recommends completing the full vaccination to all eligible citizens by December 2021 and keep the guard high in practice of CAB to keep the new infections in check. UNICEF is committed in supporting this goal and intends to expand its community engagement initiatives to reach the left behind geographies and population groups.
