3rd Phase of Re-opening of University

Dear Students,

In compliance to UGC Guidelines (November 2020), the University has planned "Third Phase of Re-opening" schedule from 4th March, 2021. Accordingly, all the Final year students of MSW, M.A.(JMC) MBA, M.Tech and MCA are advised to read the following 'Guidelines' and 'Undertaking' attached at Annexures–A & B carefully and initiate the action plan to join the Campus and to avail Hostel facility accordingly:

1. During "Third Phase of Re-opening", the Hostel facility will be provided to **eligible Boarders of Final year pursuing MSW, M.A. (JMC), MBA, M.Tech and MCA** who have availed Hostel facility during academic year 2019-20.

Note: The students who were provided "Hostel facility temporarily" in year 2019-20 are not eligible for Hostel facility.

2. Before arrival, **the Final year students of MSW, M.A.(JMC), MBA, M.Tech and MCA** (Eligible Boarders only) **must deposit the Hostel and Mess Fee** into 'Separate Accounts' on or before **02nd March, 2021**, as per below given details:

(Note: The students are advised to verify the eligibility for availing hostel facility in Third Phase of reopening with their respective Hostel Wardens /Caretakers before making payment towards "Hostel Fee" and "Hostel Mess Fee").

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3. The students are requested to send the '**Deposit Slips**' of Hostel and Mess Fee payments to provostbh@gmail.com (**Note:** The students who have paid the Hostel and Mess Fee till **3rd March, 2021** will be provided Hostel/Mess Facility from **4th March, 2021** onwards).
4. **The Final year students of MSW, M.A. (JMC), MBA, MTech and MCA (Boarders)** are also requested to **send the Date of arrival and time** on or **before 3rd March 2021** to provostbh@gmail.com so, that, accommodation and Mess facility can be arranged at **Mohammad Ali Jauhar Hostel (Boys Hostel-IV) and Qurratulain Hyder Hostel (Old Girls Hostel)**, developed as '**Quarantine Centers**'. The students who are willing to join the Hostel facility during "**Third Phase of Re-opening**" must report till **10th March, 2021**.
5. The students (Boarders/Non-Boarders) will be screened at Main Gate of University before entering in the Campus. It is mandatory for all the eligible students to report at University Health Centre to obtain '**Fitness Certificate/Health Report**' from the Doctors of University Health Centre. Only after submitting the 'Fitness Certificate/Health Report' of the Doctor of University Health Centre, the student will be provided accommodation at respective Hostels. In case, if any student is having any symptoms of COVID-19, then the student may be asked to leave the campus immediately to get clinically accessed. Therefore, students are advised to reach campus on **any working**



days during working hours, so that mandatory screening can be done to obtain 'Fitness Certificate/Health Report'.

6. Further, it is mandatory for Borders Students to be 'Quarantined' for a period of fourteen (14) days in separate rooms at Mohammad Ali Jauhar Hostel (Boys Hostel-IV) and Qurratulain Hyder Hostel (Old Girls Hostel), developed as 'Quarantine Centers'.
7. The Eligible Boarders must bring her/his own masks, sanitizers and a thermometer for monitoring body temperature for personal use. Further, the students shall bring toothpaste, soaps/shampoo, shaving kits, blades, hair oil and other items of general use, so that, it can utilized during 14 days of her/his Quarantine.
8. Moreover, in case, if any of the student develops "Covid-19 Symptoms" during quarantine, the student will be asked to get 'Clinical Assessment' at Government Hospitals. Once, the student becomes well and bring the 'Negative Test Report' of "RT-PCR - COVID-19", he/ she will be allowed to join the Campus/Hostels.
9. The Eligible Students shall download and go through the 'Undertaking' attached at Annexure (A). Before, coming to the University, the students must bring the 'Undertaking' duly signed by his/her Parent/Guardian to get Hostel Accommodation.
10. The University is in the process of acquiring "Health Insurance" for all the students, but, the number of students who are joining the Campus /Hostels during different phases of re-opening are less than the required numbers, hence, the premium amount of "Health Insurance" offered /provided by the insurance companies are not economical.
11. In case of COVID-19 infection, the student will be hospitalized at Government Hospitals only. In case, the student prefers her/his treatment at 'Private Hospitals', then, the cost of Hospitalization / Medical Treatment will be borne by the student or her/his parents only.
12. Moreover, the 'Non-Boarder' students (Girls & Boys) can visit the Campus/Departments after 'prior permission' from the 'Head of the Department' during "Third Phase of Re-opening" from 4th March 2021.
13. The Eligible 'Non-Boarder' students (Girls & Boys) shall download and go through the 'Undertaking' attached at Annexure (B). Before, coming to the University, the students shall bring the 'Undertaking' duly signed by his/her Parent/Guardian. The student must submit the 'Undertaking' to Head of their respective Departments.
14. All the Eligible Students 'Boarders/ Non-Boarders' have to strictly follow the Guidelines of the University as given in the 'Undertakings- A & B'.



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15. The Eligible Students who will be allowed to stay in Hostels/Campus must follow the Guidelines/ advisories issued by Government of India, Government of Telangana, UGC, and Ministry of Education and co-operate with University authorities in implementing Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for safety and health protocol regarding **COVID19 Pandemic**.
16. After, '**Quarantine**' period of fourteen (14) days at Hostels, the students will be allowed to visit their respective Departments.
17. The University has right to change the Guidelines/Undertaking, in case of any exigencies arises due to **COVID-19 Pandemic in the Campus/State or surrounding areas**.
