**Sub.: Amendments in The Regulations for the MPhil and PhD Programmes of MANUU-2017 - Reg
Ref: Approval of the Vice Chancellor dated 01.01.2018.**

It is hereby notified that consequently upon receiving the observations and clarification from the stakeholders, the following amendments are approved in the **PhD Regulations, MANUU.**

Existing (Previous)	Amended
15.2 A PhD research scholar has to obtain a minimum of 55% of marks or its equivalent grade in the course work in order to be eligible to continue in the Program and submit the thesis.	15.2 A PhD research scholar has to obtain a minimum of 55% of marks or its equivalent grade in the course work in order to be eligible to continue in the Program and submit the thesis. <i>As per Examination Regulations under CBCS student has to secure a minimum 55% marks both in CIE and SEE of the course work.</i>
15.3 The Continuous Internal Evaluation in a theory course shall comprise of written tests (<i>at least two</i>); assignments/annotated bibliographies/review papers (at least one); and presentations/seminars (at least one).	15.3 The Continuous Internal Evaluation in a theory course shall comprise of written tests (at least two <i>or average of best two</i>); assignments/annotated bibliographies/review papers (at least one); and presentations/seminars (at least one). <i>Each component shall be of 10 marks.</i>
18.5 The Pre Submission Seminar shall be held at least three (03) months prior to the thesis submission.	18.5 The Pre Submission Seminar application must be given in writing by the candidate to HoD through the research supervisor at least 15 days prior to the pre submission seminar.
29.1 The meeting of the Departmental Research Committee shall be held at least once every three months. It may be held earlier, depending upon urgency of individual cases.	29.1 The meeting of the Departmental Research Committee shall be held at least once every six months. It may be held earlier, depending upon urgency of individual cases.
29.2 A research scholar shall appear before the Research Advisory Committee <i>once in six months (preferably in the last month of the semester)</i> to make a presentation of the progress of his/her work for evaluation and further guidance. <i>The half-yearly progress reports</i> shall be submitted by the Research Advisory Committee to the Head of the Department/ Director of the Centre with a copy to the research scholar.	29.2 A research scholar shall appear before the Research Advisory Committee once in <i>three months</i> to make a presentation of the progress of his/her work for evaluation and further guidance. The RAC Minutes on progress report shall be submitted by the Research Advisory Committee to the Head of the Department/ Director of the Centre with a copy to the research scholar <i>and Academic Section.</i>

The same amendment shall be applicable to the corresponding Clauses of MPhil Regulations i.e. 12.2; 12.3; 15.4; 25.1 & 25.2 respectively.
