The Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, vide orders No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A), dated 27th May, 2021 has directed that the guidelines for surveillance, containment and caution in connection with COVID-19 order as annexed, will be in force upto 30th June, 2021.


In view of the above, it shall be noted that the University shall function in accordance with the Orders and the Guidelines and directives referred above issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs. (Copy enclosed). However, National directives for COVID-19 Management as annexed, in the referred order are also to be followed strictly.

1. The COVID-19 Monitoring Committee (MANUU Health Committee) of MANUU will assess the situation regularly and suggest / take the required precautionary measures for the containment of COVID-19 pandemic.
2. Further, the COVID-19 Monitoring Committee would continue to take care of the mental health and well being of all the stake holders of the University and help them to overcome the stress, tension, depression and other mental issues, if any, and recommend aid and advise to the Health Committees of Satellite Campuses of the University.



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3. Moreover, the MANUU Health Committee will submit, proposal for the procurement of precautionary material as per the directive of GOI/UGC issued from time to time.
4. No Guest shall be accommodated in the University Guest House till further orders.
5. Concerned Heads of Sections/Departments/Directorates/Centers are advised to incur expenditure from the imprest for the purchases of sanitizers, face masks etc. if required they may draw advance also for the purpose.
6. The States/UT's where based on assessment of local situations to keep the spread of COVID 19 in check, local restrictions have been imposed and attendance of officers/ staff is not feasible due to such restrictions, the matter may be reported by the employee to the concerned Head / Incharge / Headquarters and they should be available online to their respective Head during the working hours and attend the Office work/online teaching, as the case may be.
7. All Off-Campuses shall also follow the specific guidelines received by the respective States/UT's wherein they are situated.



Dear Chief Secretary,

Kindly refer to Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) Order of even number issued today, vide which MHA Order dated 29.04.2021, issued to ensure compliance to the containment measures for COVID-19, as conveyed by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) D.O. letter dated 25.04.2021, has been extended upto 30th June, 2021.

2. (The strict implementation of containment and other measures has led to a declining trend in the number of new and active cases, across States & UTs, barring some areas in the Southern and North-Eastern regions.)

3. I would like to highlight that in spite of the declining trend, the number of active cases presently is still very high. It is, therefore, important that containment measures may continue to be implemented strictly. (Any relaxation by States/UTs, may be considered at an appropriate time, in a graded manner, after assessing the local situation, requirements and resources.)

4. I would, therefore, urge you to continue compliance to the containment measures, as has been advised by MoHFW in their letter dated 25.04.2021, so as to fully overcome the pandemic. In this regard, necessary directions may be issued to district authorities in your State/UT, for taking all necessary measures. (I would also advise that Orders/guidelines, issued by the respective State Governments/UT Administrations/district authorities, for implementing containment measures, should be widely disseminated to the public and to the field functionaries, for their effective implementation.) *
