CIRCULAR

Sub: *Restriction of Medicines indented/procured through pharmacy-II in compliance with CGHS and CS(MA)- other procedure-Reg.*

It was brought to the notice of the authority that some of the employees/beneficiaries are insisting the Medical Officer to include the non-admissible items in the prescription of pharmacy-II. In this regard, all the employees are hereby informed that the items (annexed) are not admissible under CGHS/CS(MA) and therefore, the same will not be prescribed in the Indent for procurement through Pharmacy-II and also will not be issued to employees / beneficiaries from pharmacy-I.

Further, it was also brought to the notice of the authority, that certain employees/beneficiaries are not collecting the medicines from pharmacy-II despite several reminders. Delay in collecting medicines leads to hampering of payment to vendor towards supply of medicines at Health Centre resulting, the vendor stops the supply of medicines due to late payment/ delay in payment. In this regard, in case any employee doesn't collect the medicine within two days after intimation, the same will be treated as received/acknowledged and future intends of employee/beneficiary will be debarred from pharmacy-II.

Furthermore, the employees/beneficiaries shall be invariably present while getting prescription/ indent of Pharmacy-II. In case of specialist's recommendations, latest original prescription of the specialist (a copy at least 6 month's older or latest as on date of prescription) along with the patient, shall be submitted and the same should be enclosed along with the prescription during payment claim of the vendor.

ANNEXURE

List of items not admissible under CGHS notified by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare-Government of India.

- ❖ VITAMINS:
Multivitamin/Tablets/Drops/Liquid/ Capules/Syrup and any similar preparations
UPRISE D3, EVION and similar preparations etc.
- ❖ MINERALS:
Minerlas like Calcium, Zinc & Magnesium in any forms Tablets/Drops/Liquid/
Capules/Syrup and product like DEXORANGE & UPRISE D3, REJUNEX CD3,
CALCIMAX FORTE, SHELCAL, ZINCOVIT and similar preparations etc.
- ❖ LAXATIVE:
Laxatives like CREMAFFIN, DUPHALAC, LOOZ and similar preparations etc
- ❖ ANTI-OXIDANTS:
Anti-Oxidants like OMEGA 36 SOFTGEL CAP, E-COD OMEGA 30S and similar
preparations etc
- ❖ FOOD SUPPLEMENT like PROHANCE D, ENSURE, PEDIASURE and similar
preparations etc
- ❖ ANTISEPTIC product like BETADINE GARGLE, Dettol and similar product etc.
- ❖ VACCINES in general
- ❖ DEVICE like BP apparatus, Glucometer, Spacer etc
- ❖ Body wash lotions, sprays products like Kojivit, Madiphala B.Nath etc.
- ❖ Any other AYUSH medicines like SAFI, LIV 52, SEPTILIN etc.

However in any special circumstances, if the claim is legitimate, the employee can apply for reimbursement.
