The theme for International Women's Day (8 March) 2020 is - *I am Generation Equality: Realizing Women's Rights*. The theme is aligned with UN Women's new multigenerational campaign, Generation Equality, which marks the 25th anniversary of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action. The year 2020 represents an opportunity to mobilize global action to achieve gender equality and human rights for all women and girls.
