Describing Maulana Abul Kalam Azad as the architect of India's modern education system, Urdu Academy (Bhopal) Deputy Secretary (retired) Iqbal Masood on Thursday said that Maulana Azad laid the foundation of basic educational structure in the country post-independence.

Maulana Azad, India's First Education Minister, is also credited with setting up of various elite institutions, such as UGC, IITs, Sahitya Akademi, Sangeet Natak Akademi, and National School of Drama in the country.

"In Independent India, Maulana Azad always wanted to maintain the true legacy of this beloved country; that is why he had laid the foundation of various premier institutions like University Grants Commission, Indian Institutes of Technology, Sahitya Akademi, Sangeet Natak Akademi, and National School of Drama. No one could even imagine this from a learned Muslim scholar," Mr. Masood opined.

He was speaking at the "Azad Day / National Education Day Celebration" (8-11 November 2021) which was organized here today by College of Teacher Education-Bhopal (a constituent college of Maulana Azad National Urdu University).
