






Paradigm Shift in Teacher Education

INTRODUCTION

Teacher education refers to the policies and procedures designed to equip teachers with the knowledge, attitudes, behaviours and skills they require to perform their tasks effectively in the school and classroom.

Teacher education is often divided into:

- (1) Initial teacher training/education (a preservice course before entering the classroom as a fully responsible teacher).
- (2) Induction (the process of providing training and support during the first few years of teaching or the first year in a school.
- (3) Teacher development or continuing professional development (an in-service process for practicing teachers.

The quality and standards of an education system largely depend on the quality, characteristics and commitment of the teachers to their profession. The Education Commission 1964-66 therefore pointed out, "For the qualitative improvement of education a sound programme of professional education of teachers is essential". It is essential to improve teacher education through a sound
