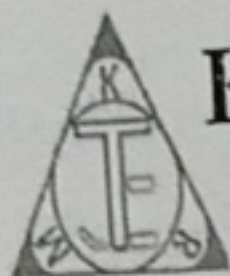

Relationship of Values and Professional Aptitude of B.Ed. Students with their Academic Achievement

Abstract

In this research paper I have tried to identify the various dimensions of values and professional aptitude of B.Ed. students and also to investigate the relationship of values and professional aptitudes of B.Ed. students with their academic achievement. For this purpose, the sample of study consisted of 600 students doing B.Ed. from various NCTE, recognized B.Ed. colleges of private, state government and central government of Bidar district, Karnataka. Tool used for identification of values of B.Ed. students was "Brief Scale of Values (B.S.V.)" developed by Dr. Yashveer Singh of Agra, and in order to know the teaching aptitude of B.Ed. students, the researcher has used Teaching Aptitude Test Battery (T.A.T.B) developed by Dr. R.P. Singh and Dr. S.N. Sharma of Patna University.

Introduction
