

Introduction:

In the era of communication and speed, advancements about education are coordinated with technology; hence it is necessary for these advancements to be followed by the educational departments day by day "speed learning methods" are developed for student to accelerate his her learning process. While student-cantered approaches especially in learning processes necessitate use of different materials, course materials vary from course books which base on word to internet usage. Teaching methods which are used in digital axial age wriggle out from printed methods and progress towards teaching methods which serve for multi-sensation andcentre efficiency and speed in teaching. Audio-visual method which is one of those methods is envisioned to be usedeffectively through films in teaching languages.
